1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') is for issuance of
directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct free and fair investigation in FIR
No.12 dated 12.03.2023 under Sections 406 & 498-A of the Indian Penal Code,
1860, registered at Police Women Cell, Phase 8, District SAS Nagar (Mohali)
and to take appropriate and necessary action against respondents No.5 to 9 and
further to direct learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar (Mohali) to
release the amount of Rs.1.00 lac deposited by respondent No.4 in the name of
the petitioner at the time of grant of anticipatory bail and also to direct

respondent No.3 to release the car i.e. Maruti Swift to the petitioner, which was given to respondent No.4 in dowry by her father.

2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition has been substantially redressed, as the investigating agency has already concluded the investigation and presented the final report under Section 193 of BNSS (*erstwhile Section 173 of Cr.P.C.*) before the concerned jurisdictional Court, therefore, nothing survives in the present petition.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to raise all the pleas taken in the present petition at the appropriate stage before the Court concerned.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
