Prayer in the present petition is for directing the Principal Judge, Family Court, S.A.S. Nagar, to dispose of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, registered as HMA Case No.423 of 2023, expeditiously and preferably within a period of six months.

2 It is evident that the aforesaid petition has been filed by the petitioner only in the month of May 2023 and after completion of service and filing of reply, the issues were framed on 20.08.2024 and the matter was fixed for 25.10.2024 for evidence of the petitioner. It is evident from a

perusal of the aforesaid that no unnecessary delay is being caused by the Principal Judge, Family Court, S.A.S. Nagar in taking up the matter or adjourning the matter.

3 No sufficient grounds are made out for issuing any directions as prayed for by the petitioner to the Principal Judge, Family Court, S.A.S. Nagar since the issuance of any such direction is likely to disturb the case management system and the procedure being adopted by the Principal Judge, Family Court, S.A.S. Nagar. It seems that the present petition is stemmed by an overgrown anxiety to cut the limb and to seek special directions. Such an attempt cannot be promoted by this Court as every case pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court, S.A.S. Nagar, is important and deserves equal treatment. No preferential treatment can be extended to the case of the petitioner.

4 The present petition is thus dismissed.
