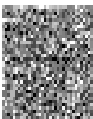

HARPREET KAUR JEEWAN, J.

1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to official respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the private respondent No.5 had filed a similar complaint before Economic Offences Wing, District Bathinda, as such, the petitioner was constrained to approach this Court by way of filing a petition bearing No.CRWP-2665-2024. The said petition was disposed of by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 16.05.2024 (Annexure P-7) with the direction that the authorities not to call upon the petitioner unnecessarily except if he is found to be involved in violation of any law.

3. As per the status report dated 13.11.2024 filed by Rajinder Pal Singh,



PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Detective), District Barnala, subsequent to the passing of the order by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, another complaint bearing No.3110/VP dated 26.09.2024 was entertained, whereby both the parties were summoned and heard.

4. Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurdayal Singh has confirmed that petitioner is not required in this case. Learned State counsel also submits that even otherwise the dispute originated in Canada between the petitioner's daughter and respondent No.5's son and no substantive grounds have emerged under local jurisdiction, as such, enquiry/investigation stands completed.

5. In view of the said undertaking given by the State counsel, the present petition is disposed of.

6. However, State shall remain bound by the said undertaking.

7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
