1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and its workers which has been severely prejudiced/threatened at the hands of the private respondents No.6 to 20 being the representative of a private/independent Labour Union, namely, Punjabi Pardesh Paldedar Mazdoor Union, Zira, Ferozepur, where the petitioner has been allotted the work of labour for PEG Cluster Friends Associates, PEG Godown, Behak Gujran, Zira Ferozepur pursuant to Punjab Labour and Cartage Policy, 2024 vide allotment letter dated 01.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) for a period of one year and the same is being disrupted by the illegal and nefarious activities of the private respondents. Further prayer has been made for directing the Official Respondents to independently and fairly inquire into and adjudicate upon the Representation dated 02.10.2024 (Annexure P/2) which has been filed by the Petitioner against the unscrupulous activities of Respondent Nos.6 to 20 and further to direct Respondent Nos.1 to 5 to



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take necessary steps to ensure and safeguard the Petitioner and its employees/labourers from the unscrupulous activities of Private Respondents Nos. 6 to 20 to ensure smooth and proper completion of the allotted tender work.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has filed a representation dated 02.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. She has further submitted that petitioner would be satisfied if representation dated 02.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) is decided in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

5. Heard.

6. After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur is directed to decide the representation dated 02.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.

7. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
