1. The present petition has been filed Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for punishing the respondent for wilful disobedience of order dated 27.07.2023 passed by this Court in CWP 16005-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order qua which the contempt is asserted; has since been complied and no further action is required to be taken in the matter.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the factual position.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any of the grievances of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
