1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the respondent-authorities to consider the petitioner's complaint/representation dated 14.07.2023 (Annexure P-1), representation dated 14.08.2023 (Annexure P-2) and reminder dated 15.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) and register an FIR against the accused persons.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been running from pillar to post but his grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioner has approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, respondent No.3 by way of representation dated 15.10.2023 (Annexure P-3), but the same is also

pending decision. He also submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala respondent No.3 to consider the representation dated 15.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months from today.
