1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 8 and take action on their representation dated 30.09.2024 (Annexure P-3).

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners want to marry each other. However, respondents no. 4 to 8 did not agree with the same as petitioner no.1 is already married and is having two children. Proceedings are pending between petitioner no.1 and respondent no.8. Moreover they are giving threats to the petitioners to eliminate them and implicating petitioner no.1 in some false cases. Apprehending danger to their lives and liberty, they sent representation dated



30.09.2024 to the respondent No.2 but the same has not been taken into consideration and hence, the present petition.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. Mr. Satjot Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, at this stage. The petitioners’ counsel is directed to supply the copy of the petition to her.
- 5. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel without going into the legality of their relationship and without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the veracity of the averments made in the petition and also with regard to the sanctity of relationship or age of the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into the matter and dispose of the representation dated 30.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) within a period of 15 days and also to take necessary step, if any, genuine threat to life and liberty of the petitioners is found.
- 6. A copy of this order along with copy of representation dated 30.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2, so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
- 7. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
