Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the FIR in question has been registered after a delay of two days which has not been explained. Moreover, the complainant has got his medical conducted after visiting the Civil Hospital, Sirsa from a private hospital.

The learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Gurdial Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kalanwali, District Sirsa, on behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place in the file.

State counsel submits that the petitioner is specifically named in the FIR and he is the main accused. He further submits that the petitioner is a habitual offender and involved in ten more cases prior to the registration of the present FIR and, therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required for recovery of the weapon of offence.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the role attributed to the petitioner, this Court finds no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and, thus, the present petition stands dismissed.
