1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that they should not be made to do the Election duty keeping in view the Instructions dated 07.06.2023, which have been issued, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-1.

Learned State counsel submits that the elections are scheduled for tomorrow and in case, at this stage, the petitioners are taken off from the duty, the election process will be derailed, which will not be in the interest of anyone and in the next election, due care will be taken for implementation of the Instructions dated 07.06.2023 or the Instructions which will be available on the said date with regard to performance of the election duty by the Officers of the State of Punjab.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
