The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in FIR No.0102 dated 12.09.2024 registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 333, 351(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS of 2023, at Police Station, Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. A status report by way of an affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Batala has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record.
4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined

the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 18.10.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
