1. Through the instant second petition, filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023, a prayer is made for grant of relief of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.21, dated 08.04.2024 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 204 of the IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Cyber Crime, Kurukshetra.
2. Custody Certificate dated 18.10.2024, qua the petitioner, furnished by learned State counsel today, in the Court. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof, supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. There is no supervening or changed circumstances in the instant matter, after the first regular bail application, having been dismissed as withdrawn, vide order dated 21.08.2024 (Annexure-P-2), and without waiting further for the progress of the trial, the instant petition has been filed, within a period of two months approximately. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to consider the case of the present petitioner, to grant the asked for relief (supra).
4. Accordingly, the instant petition is, hereby, **dismissed**.
