The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.
read with Section 482 of Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in FIR mentioned
below:-

2. The aforementioned FIR has been registered on the basis of
statement recorded by the complainant on the allegations that the petitioner
along with the co-accused had found membership of unlawful assembly and
in prosecution of common object of the said unlawful assembly had
criminally trespassed into his house on the night of 11.09.2023 and had
assaulted him and his family members and caused injuries to them.

3. After registration of FIR, investigation proceedings have been
initiated and are underway. The petitioner has joined the investigation on

03.11.2024. His custodial interrogation is no more required. As such, no purpose would be served by detaining him in custody. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the order dated 18.10.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to compliance of usual terms and conditions requisite for grant of anticipatory bail.
