- Through the instant second petition, filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., a prayer is made for grant of relief of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.140, dated 04.12.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 22(C)/29/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station ‘D’ Division, Amritsar.
- Custody Certificate dated 21.10.2024, qua the petitioner, furnished by learned State counsel today, in the Court. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof, supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
- There is no supervening or changed circumstances in the instant matter, after the first regular bail application, having been dismissed as withdrawn, vide order dated 27.08.2024 (Annexure-P-3), and without waiting further for the progress of the trial, the instant petition has been filed, within a period of two months approximately. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to consider the case of the present petitioner, to grant the asked for relief (supra).
- Accordingly, the instant petition is, hereby, **dismissed**.
