1. By this common order, two writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being decided as both these petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioners had appeared in Haryana Subordinate Accounts Services (HSAS) Part-II examination, which was held in August, 2019 and have raised certain grievance with regard to the conduct of the said examination and a representation was filed to the Additional Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, Department of Finance for the award of the grace marks and also highlighting the irregularity committed during the conduct of the said examination.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners will be satisfied in case any decision is taken by the respondent-department on the said representation in a time bound manner.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representation has been received in the office of the Additional Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, Department of Finance and is still pending consideration with the department concerned and no final decision has been taken on the ground raised by the petitioners in the said representation, appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. Any miscellaneous application, if pending, stands disposed of.
