1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that there is a disciplinary proceeding, which is pending against the petitioner, which is not being decided and certain pensionary benefits have been withheld though more than four years have been passed.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaganeshwar Walia, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the disciplinary proceedings pending against the petitioner keeping in view the charge-sheet dated 30.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) have not attained finality, the same will be finalized within a period of four months from the receipt of copy of this order in case, the petitioner cooperates with the Department and



after finalizing, whatever benefit is admissible to the petitioner, the same will also be released to the petitioner within a further period of eight weeks.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
