Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.94 dated 25.05.2023 registered under Sections 67 and 67-A of Information Technology Act, 2000, at Police Station, City District Rupnagar.

2. Allegations in brief are that petitioner clicked photographs of victim in naked condition and uploaded the same on internet by making a fake I.D on 07.05.2023.

3. Learned counsel contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Also contends that he is in custody since 22.05.2023; charges have already been framed and the case is pending for prosecution evidence.

4. *Per contra*, learned State counsel while opposing the prayer submits that petitioner had actively participated in the commission of crime. Also submits that allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature; thus, he does not deserve the concession of bail.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.

It transpires that the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature as he has clicked the photographs of victim in a naked condition and thereafter uploaded the same on the internet which disentitles him for the grant of bail at this stage.

In view of the above, there is no option, except to dismiss the petition.

Ordered accordingly.
