Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.121 dated 17.07.2020, under Sections 120-B, 148, 302, 307 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station, City Narwana, District Jind.

(2) After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, is not pressing the petition on merits, however, he submits that in view of the custody of petitioner, learned trial Court be directed to conclude the proceedings on some early date.

(3) In view of the above, present petition is disposed off with a request to learned trial Court to avoid unwarranted adjournments and proceed in the matter expeditiously, as per law.

(4) Superintendent of Police as well as Superintendent, District Jail, Jind are mandated to fully cooperate with the learned trial Court. In case there is failure, in production of prosecution witnesses or accused, the same shall entail legal consequences.

(5) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
