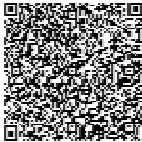

Amarjot Bhatti, J.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition for anticipatory bail.

I have gone through the file. This petition for anticipatory bail has been filed in a complaint case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and Section 420 of IPC. The petitioner has annexed the interlocutory orders (Annexure P-2) which show that talk regarding compromise was going on between the parties and in pursuance of the same, some amount was also deposited. Thereafter, present petitioner absented before the trial court on 21.2.2024. As a result, his bail was cancelled and his bonds were forfeited to the State. His arrest warrant was issued for 15.3.2024. Thereafter present petitioner has annexed another order dated 5.8.2024 which shows that proclamation proceedings were initiated and as per last order dated 11.9.2024, presence of present petitioner was awaited for 23.9.2024. As per order dated 23.9.2024 downloaded by this Court,



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present petitioner has already been declared proclaimed person and the SHO concerned has been directed to register FIR under Section 174-A IPC. Today during the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the aforesaid order has not been uploaded. Therefore, he was unable to procure this order.

Considering the factual position, it is clear that learned counsel for the petitioner tried to mislead the Court by concealing aforesaid order dated 23.9.2024 passed by the trial court.

Considering the aforesaid conduct, petitioner is permitted to withdraw this petition, subject to deposit of costs of Rs.20,000/- with the Institute for the Blind at Sector 26, Chandigarh and receipt thereof be placed on record.
