In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the father of the petitioner who was working as Constable died while in service and the petitioner had claimed compassionate appointment after the death of his father which is not being finalised for the reason as mentioned in the present writ petition hence, the respondents be directed to finalised the claim of the petitioner for the grant of compassionate appointment in accordance with the law in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the legal notice dated 24.06.2024, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-11 and the

petitioner will be, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 24.06.2024 (Annexure P-11) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
