1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the official respondents to take legal action against the respondents No.4 to 9 for committing forgery.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioner has already submitted a complaint dated 04.09.2024 (Annexure P-9) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to look into complaint dated 04.09.2024 (Annexure P-9) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
