The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to release the Registration Certificate of the Vehicle No.PB01C9659 as the vehicle had been registered on 31.03.2020 and Form No.24 of the vehicle has already been issued and the details of the vehicle are being shown on the portal of the Transport Department but the RC of the vehicle is not being given to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, he has submitted various representations including recent representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No. 2, but no action has been taken by the respondent-Department on the said representations. Hence, the present writ petition.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Niharika Sharma, AAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No. 2-State Transport Commissioner, Punjab-cum-Regional Transport Authority, Sector 17, Chandigarh, is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2-State Transport Commissioner, Punjab-cum-Regional Transport Authority, Sector 17, Chandigarh, to consider and decide the representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
