1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 14.08.2019 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Hisar vide which application filed by plaintiff No.1/petitioner under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC read with Section 151 CPC has been dismissed.
