Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondent to consider the application of the petitioner bearing No.202313288 dated 03.10.2023 for registration as Pharmacist.

Learned standing counsel for the respondent-Punjab Pharmacy Council has informed that the petitioner has undertaken his course from the Royal College of Pharmacy which is stated to be affiliated to the Singhania University, Pachari Bari (Jhunjhunu) Rajasthan. He contends that they have already written to the concerned University as regards the recognition granted by the Pharmacy Council of India as also to the affiliation of Royal College of Pharmacy along with the intake capacity as approved by the Pharmacy Council of India but no response is forthcoming and in the absence of any such response, the claim made by the petitioner cannot be verified. He further submits that neither the Pharmacy Council of India nor the affiliating University or the institution has been made as a party in the present petition.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition so as to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action with better and complete particulars.

Disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
