The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the complaint dated 12.07.2019 (Annexure P-4) submitted by respondent No.3 against the petitioner as no offence under the Sexual Harassment of Women at Work Place (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 is made out against the petitioner and further sought a writ of mandamus directing respondent No.5 not to proceed further and to handover the proceedings conducted till now on the said complaint to the Local Complaints Committee as respondent No.7, vide order dated 01.10.2019, has already transferred the said complaint to the Local Complaints Committee.
