1. Petitioner –Simranjit Singh @ Simar has filed petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.50 dated 19.02.2023, under Section 379-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

2. As per facts of the case, Kuldeep Kaur gave her statement that on 19.02.2023, she along with her mother Harminder Kaur was coming from village Jahura to village Bains Awana on their TVS scooty No. AF and when they crossed bridge of Gurudwara towards village Miani, two clean shaven persons came on motorcycle and stopped motorcycle in front of her scooty. They snatched her purse hanging in front of scooty and escaped on their motorcycle. She was carrying her gold chain, mobile phone and some



money in the said purse. With these allegations, present FIR has been registered.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that petitioner is falsely implicated in this case. He was already arrested in another FIR No.69 dated 06.03.2023, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur and later on he was falsely involved in this case. Learned counsel for petitioner further pointed out that statement of complainant Kuldeep Kaur has been recorded as PW-1 where she has not supported the case of prosecution. Petitioner is behind the bars since long. Therefore, his regular bail petition may be allowed.

4. Bail petition is opposed by learned counsel representing State. Status report has been filed. It is pointed out that there are specific serious allegations against present petitioner. He is having criminal antecedents. As per para No.6 of the status report, petitioner is involved in FIR No.69 dated 06.03.2023, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur and FIR No.65 dated 03.03.2023, under Section 379-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur. Considering the gravity of offence, petitioner is not entitled to be released on bail.

5. I have considered the arguments and have gone through the record. As per report received from concerned trial Court, statement of complainant Kuldeep Kaur has been recorded who has not identified the accused facing trial in this case. Present petitioner is behind the bars for the last about 11 months. Trial in this case may take some time. So far as other FIRs are concerned, same will be decided on its own merits. Therefore,

without expressing my mind on merits of the case, regular bail petition filed by petitioner – Simranjit Singh @ Simar is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Judge concerned.
