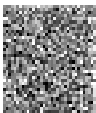

VINOD S. BHARDWAJ , J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners in the present petition sought issuance of directions to the respondents for not establishing the 66 KVA Grid on the land bearing Khewat No. 210, Khatoni No. 263, comprised in Khasra No. 22//9, 22//12 situated at village Bagrian, Tehsil and District Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.3-Gram Panchayat Bagrian assisted by the erstwhile Sarpanch namely Kulwinder



Singh as well as Sukhwinder Singh husband of Ms. Jasvir Kaur, the incumbent Sarpanch of the village, duly identified by learned counsel for respondent No.3, as well as counsel for respondent No.1-PSPCL contend that the petitioners, who had preferred the instant petition have already sold the land for which the instant petition has been filed. They, thus, contend that the petitioners would have no subsisted grouse since they have no vested right or interest in the said land.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, pleads lack of instructions in this regard.

4. Be that as it may, considering that the statement has been made by the counsel representing the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited as well as the learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.3-Gram Panchayat Bagrian assisted by the erstwhile Sarpanch namely Kulwinder Singh as well as Sukhwinder Singh husband of Ms. Jasvir Kaur, the incumbent Sarpanch of the village, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioners to seek revival of the present writ petition, in case, the aforesaid statement is found to be factually incorrect.
