The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.1 to take decision upon the representations dated 20.05.2024 and 01.07.2024 (Annexures P-6 and P-7) and Legal Notice dated 29.07.2024 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioners as respondents No.3 and 4 have uploaded the wrong information on the official portal of MCA in order to run away from the criminal liability to mislead the general public.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, he has served Legal Notice dated 29.07.2024 (Annexure P-8) to the respondent authorities but no action has been taken by them.

Notice of motion restricted to respondent No.2 only at this stage.

Mr. Piyush Khanna, Advocate appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.2-the Registrar of Companies (Punjab, Chandigarh & Himachal Pradesh), Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the Legal Notice dated 29.07.2024 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner.

Learned Counsel for respondent No.2 does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2-the Registrar of Companies (Punjab, Chandigarh & Himachal Pradesh), Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Chandigarh to consider and decide the Legal Notice dated 29.07.2024 (Annexure P-8) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
