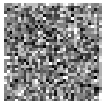
The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents for renewal of the certificate of registration of the motorcycle make Bullet Electra bearing registration No.CH-04-1953.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, he has submitted various representations including recent legal notice dated 24.06.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondents No. 2 and 3, but no action has been taken by the respondent-Department on the same. Hence, the present writ petition.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Niharika Sharma, AAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No. 2-Transport Department



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Chandigarh, Registering & Licensing Authority, Sector 17, Chandigarh, is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.06.2024 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2-Transport Department Chandigarh, Registering & Licensing Authority, Sector 17, Chandigarh, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.06.2024 (Annexure P-5) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
