The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 (Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sahita, 2023) for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to initiate appropriate legal action against the accused who has committed fraud and cheating with the petitioner by alluring her to get online job and handsome salary commission for doing said job and thereby duped her to the tune of Rs. 8,00,000/-. Further complaint submitted by the petitioner to the cybercrime police station, Gurugram, the police though put on hold the bank account of criminals and also identified them but failed to take any action against them.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, Sr. DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and at the very outset would submit that FIR No.252 dated 10.09.2024, Police Station Cyber East Gurugram has been registered against the accused persons wherein two

accused persons have already joined the investigation namely Ravi Parshad Gujjar and Sunil Jagar.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition at this stage.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
