SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of present revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has approached this Court, *inter alia*, for setting aside of order dated dated 31.10.2019, Annexure P1, passed by Civil Judge (Jr.Divn.), Jalandhar, whereby application filed by the petitioner under Section 4 read with Section 8 of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short – ‘the Act’) for referring the matter to the Arbitrator and for dismissal of the suit, has been dismissed.

2. When confronted with the maintainability of the revision petition in view of Section 37 (1) (a) of the Act, counsel for the petitioner has sought permission to withdraw the present petition with

liberty to take the recourse to the remedy available to the petitioner under the Act. He, however, submits that as an interim order has been passed in his favour, the same may be kept alive till the time he avails the remedy.

3. Although prayer has been opposed by the counsel for the respondent, but considering that the matter is pending before this Court since November, 2019, petitioner is granted permission to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty as aforesaid.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. The operation of the interim order passed by this Court on 22.11.2019 shall remain in operation for the period of one month from today in order to enable the petitioner to take recourse to the alternate remedy. It will be open to the petitioner to move appropriate application before the Appellate Court for condonation of delay, if permissible, in accordance with law.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
