The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 seeking grant of interim bail for 60 days to the petitioner in FIR No.608, dated 24.07.2024, under Section 20 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sector 58, Faridabad on medical grounds.

In compliance to the previous order dated 28.10.2024, an affidavit of Mr. Sumit Panwar, Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State along with status report from the Medical Officer (Annexure R-1), which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner in Court.

The said status report would depict as under:-

- “i) That Medical examination of said petitioner/under-trial prisoner was done at the time of admission in jail. In examination accused gave history of diabetes mellitus since 10 years. All vitals are within normal limits.*
- ii) As per record available in jail hospital, petitioner/under-trial attended jail hospital OPD in past*

for complaint of general health ailments like allergy, cough, diabetes mellitus and foot ulcer for which he was properly examined by medical officer and provided treatment.

iii) In view of diabetes mellitus with right foot ulcer on dated 10-08-2024, he was referred to Civil Hospital Faridabad where he was seen by specialist and after conducting necessary investigation he was provided medication and further referred to Safdurjung Hospital New Delhi in the department of endocrinology.

iv) He was also referred to Safdurjung Hospital New Delhi on dated 29-08-2024 in the department of endocrinology and seen by specialist and advised medications and same were provided to him in jail hospital.

v) On dated 11-09-2024, he was referred to Safdurjung Hospital New Delhi for physical medicine rehabilitation OPD and general surgery OPD where he was seen by specialist and advised medications.

vi) On dated 26-09-2024 he was referred to Safdurjung Hospital New Delhi in the department of endocrinology for follow-up and seen by specialist and advised medications.

On dated 28-10-2024, medical examination of said petitioner/under-trial was done by medical officer on duty. In medical examination, under-trial was found conscious and oriented to time, place and person. RBS - 132 Mg/DL Blood pressure 130/80 MM/HG, Pulse-90 BPM, SP02-96 @ Room Air Chest clear and at the time examination complaint of Right foot ulcer with swelling and breathlessness.”

This Court has also perused the medical record submitted by the

Officer deputed in the jail at Annexure R-1 which also corroborate the stand

taken by the State in its affidavit.

The assertion made in the petition are correct in the light of verification report/status filed on behalf of the respondent/State and in the light of above, since the petitioner is under treatment at Safdurjung Hospital, New Delhi for physical medicine rehabilitation and general surgery OPD by specialists, it would be appetite in the circumstances of the instant petition that the same is accepted enabling the petitioner to get proper medication for speedy recovery.

The aforesaid observation is pertinent in the light of the fact that nature of injury is not chronic or permanent in nature but can be cured after taking due care and timely medication for which he is already undergoing treatment at Safdurjung Hospital in New Delhi. For enabling him to continue with the said medication with much more effective/positive results and to expedite rehabilitation process, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail for a period of six weeks from today i.e. 29.10.2024, subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Illaq Magistrate.

It is however, made clear that the petitioner shall surrender to the Jail authorities, concerned on or before 11.12.2024, by 05:00 p.m.

The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
