The claim of the petitioner in the present petition is that they were entitled for the regularisation of their services keeping in view the services rendered by them and the question of law raised in the present petition has already been decided by this Court while passing order in CWP No.26714 of 2019 titled “*Hira Devi and ors. Vs. State of Punjab and ors.*”, decided n 19.07.2024.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners have already filed a representation, copies of which have been appended as Annexure P-14 dated 05.05.2013, 25.09.2018 and 19.07.2019 and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the

respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Satnampreet Singh Chauhan, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 05.05.2013, 25.09.2018 and 19.07.2019 (Annexure P-14) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
