Main Case

This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1917 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 25.10.2021 passed in CWP-21269-2021.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 has been filed in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Satish Kumar, DDPO Gurdaspur, who is present in the Court, has submitted that the order dated 25.10.2021 passed in CWP-21369-2021 has been complied with and necessary order dated 16.10.2023 has been passed.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.

The aforesaid officer, who is present in the Court, is discharged from the present proceedings.
