The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.53 dated 29.09.2023 registered under Sections 379-B, 324, 323, 341, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Dorangla, District Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 05.01.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

An affidavit dated 13.01.2024 by way of an affidavit of Aditya Warriar, IPS, Asstt. Superintendent of Police, Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 05.01.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
