The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant pre-arrest bail to him in case FIR No.33 dated 22.02.2015 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Division Begowal, District Kapurthala.

In the present case, the petition was filed in the year 2018 initially and the Registry had raised certain objections, however, the objections had not been cleared and no steps were taken by the learned counsel for the petitioner for getting the matter listed.
