1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 15.09.2023 (Annexure P-6) whereby the application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act for the grant of interim maintenance has been allowed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted that since in the present case, the divorce has been granted under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such.
