The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus seeking release of her daughter Navjot Kaur aged about 25 years who is stated to be in illegal custody of respondent No.4-Sandeep Singh.

2. In compliance of the previous order dated 14.11.2024, aforesaid Navjot Kaur has appeared along with Sandeep Singh. Navjot Kaur has made statement that she is 25 years of age and is not willing to live with her parents and is presently living with Sandeep Singh of her

own free will and consent without any pressure from the side of any quarter. She further stated that she was never illegally confined by any person including respondents No.4 to 9 and that the allegations made in the present petition are false and the same be disposed of.

3. In light of the aforesaid statement recorded by Navjot Kaur today in the Court, the present petition is hereby disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
