1. Present civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the action of the official respondents, vide which the nomination forms of two male candidates i.e. respondents No.7 & 8 have been accepted and approved for the seat, which is reserved for Scheduled Caste (Women) i.e. Block and District Ferozepur, Sr. No.78, Gram Panchayat Mehal Singh Wala, Wards No.1 & 2 and also for quashing the action of the official respondents,

vide which nomination of respondents No.9 to 12 have been accepted for election to the post of Panches, despite the fact that they did not fulfill the required conditions and are not possessing No Objection Certificate.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Shivam, Returning Officer, submits that inadvertently, the nomination forms of two male candidates i.e. respondents No.7 & 8 were accepted with respect to the seat in question, which have now been withdrawn by them and thus, the present petition has become infructuous.

3. In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned State counsel, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
