By way of present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

2 Notice of motion.

3 On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sartaj Singh Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

4 As per the petitioners, they have married on 03.10.2024 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6, who happen to be the family members of petitioner No.2.

5 Both the petitioners have claimed themselves to be major relying upon Aadhar card indicating that petitioner No.1-Dikshant Verma is 10.02.1996 born and petitioner No.2-Prachita Thakur is 24.05.1999 born.



6 Without commenting on the legality and validity of the marriage, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 03.10.2024 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioners.

7 Keeping in view the fact that both the petitioners claim to have married, I think that if possible, respondent No.2 may call a meeting of the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 to 6 in his presence, so that the parties get rid off their ill feelings and live amicably.

8 The petition stands disposed off.
