1. *Suo-motu* cognizance was taken by this Court on the incident of burglary and arson in the house which was in occupation of a Trainee Judge at Ambala in the intervening night of 04/05.10.2024.
2. After taking cognizance, this Court issued notice to the State of Haryana and its functionaries.
3. The status report alongwith affidavit of Surinder Singh Bhorla, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Ambala, which has been filed in Court today and is taken on record, reveals that the sole accused – Ravinder Kumar has been arrested and several items have been recovered based on his disclosure statement leading to preparation of seizure memo whereafter the investigation has been completed and the final report would be submitted on an early date.
4. In this view of the matter, it would be appropriate that this petition is disposed of with a direction to the State of Haryana and its

functionaries to expedite the conduction and conclusion of investigation. The charge-sheet be filed as expeditiously as possible preferably by 31.12.2024.

5. The petition, accordingly, stands disposed of.
