1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short ‘BNSS’), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 95 dated 01.08.2024, registered under Sections 331(4), 305(a) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short-‘BNS’) (Sections 303 (2, 4), 317(2) of BNS added later on), at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala.
2. Vide order dated 11.10.2024, passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 27.10.2024 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.
4. Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, therefore, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.10.2024, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to compliance of usual terms and conditions requisite for grant of anticipatory bail.
