Instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been preferred seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

2. Heard.

3. A perusal of the file reveals that a detailed affidavit/reply dated 15.10.2024 in the matter had been filed by the Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh.

4. It is submitted by the petitioner that he had already moved a detailed representation dated 20.09.2024 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, (Mohali) mentioning the facts and circumstances but no action has been taken on the said representation by the



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concerned authority. He submits that for the purpose of the present petition, the he will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and dispose of the representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Upon asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has assured that the aforesaid representation shall be dealt with in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

6. Considering the aforesaid circumstances and the limited request made by the petitioner-present in person, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-The Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, (Mohali) to consider the averments made in the representation dated 20.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) in an expeditious manner after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and dispose of the same in accordance with the law.

7. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner in writing.

8. Disposed of.
