This application has been filed for placing on record affidavit of the complainant as Annexure C-1 in compliance to the order dated 22.10.2024.

For the reasons mentioned in the application and keeping in view the submission made by counsel for the applicant, the application is allowed and affidavit of the complainant as Annexure C-1 is taken on record.

Main case

The instant petition under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0296, dated 30.06.2024 under Sections 471, 468, 467, 420, 419, 406, 120-B IPC of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra.



Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has made the payment to the complainant.

As per the paragraph no.2 of the application, the complainant has received the payment from the various accused persons which is detailed below in tabular form :-

This Court vide order dated 22.10.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 22.10.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Investing Officer does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the submissions and the fact that an amount of Rs. 14,37,000/- has already been received by the complainant from various accused persons out of total amount of Rs. 35 lakhs, the bona
