KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. Counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* submits that certain police officials of Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana in civil clothes visited the house of the petitioners at odd hours on at least two occasions just to harass the petitioners who are not involved in any criminal case. It is further submitted that in this regard one representation dated 03.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) was submitted to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that petitioners will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide representation (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law, at the earliest.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents and on instructions from ASI Harbhol Singh



submits that actually Shaunki Dhiman son of petitioner No.1 is required by the police of police station Daba in a case having FIR No.67 dated 18.09.2024 under Sections 103, 115(2), 191(3), 190, 194(2), 351(3) of BNS, 2023 and in order to apprehend the said accused the police is raiding various places including house of his father but the said accused is still absconding. The copy of concerned FIR which is produced by the State counsel is taken on record.

4. In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the police authorities not to unnecessarily harass the petitioners, who are not required by the police with regard to any criminal case. Further direction is given to respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to consider and decide representation dated 03.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioners in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
