1. Present revision petition has been preferred against the order dated 05.09.2019 passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Karnal, whereby, the application filed by the petitioner under Section 125 Cr.P.C. for grant of maintenance has been partly allowed.

2. Mr. Sunil Kumar Rana, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and filed his memo of appearance.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the petitioner and respondent both have filed a joint petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, seeking dissolution of their marriage, by way of mutual consent and at the time of granting of divorce the petitioner has received Rs.24,90,000/- as full and final settlement towards his past, present and future alimony and he has relied upon the judgment passed by learned Family Court. A copy of the judgment dated 21.05.2022 passed by the learned Family Court at Karnal is produced. The same is taken on record

subject to all just exceptions. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place. The perusal of the same would indicate that the petitioner has received Rs.24,90,000/- from respondent as full and final settlement.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as withdrawn as having been rendered as infructuous.
