JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to pay him salary for the period from 01.04.2018 to 03.12.2018.
2. The petitioner in his petition has made multiple prayers, however, Mr. Bajwa, petitioner, restricts his grievance to release of salary for the period from 01.04.2018 to 03.12.2018.
3. The petitioner submits that it is undisputed fact that he has served with respondent during the said period still he has not been paid salary on the ground that he had filed wrong affidavit with respect to his another employment.

4. On being asked, learned counsel for the respondents does not dispute the fact that petitioner, during the said period, had worked with respondent-organization and he has not been paid salary for the said period. He further submits that salary was not paid because petitioner had filed incorrect affidavit with respect to his employment.

5. As per the respondent, the petitioner during the relevant period was also rendering service of security agency, thus, he could not be appointed on the post of officer in-charge.

6. It is undisputed fact that petitioner during the period in question had served with the respondent and no recovery is pending against him, thus, he cannot be denied salary for the period he had served the respondent. Accordingly, the respondents are directed to release salary of the petitioner within 3 months from today.

7. Disposed of in above terms.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
