In the instant petition, this Court vide order dated 07.11.2023 directed the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period two weeks from that day and in case the petitioner surrenders within the aforesaid period of two weeks and files an application for grant of bail, then he was required to be admitted on interim bail.

Thereafter, there is consistent non-appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner either in person or through his counsel.
