1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.77, dated 04.09.2024, under Sections 108 (306 IPC) and 351(2) of BNS, registered at Police Station Sadar ,District Ahmedgarh.
