1. At the outset, learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that appropriate speaking order granting relief to the petitioner has already been passed, hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a speaking order has been passed granting certain benefits but the same was passed in April, 2023 and despite the fact that more than one and half year has already lapsed but the benefits as admissible to the petitioner under the said speaking order dated 24.04.2023 have not been extended.
3. Learned State counsel submits that in case, the benefits in pursuance to the speaking order have not been released to the petitioner, all benefits admissible to the petitioner will be released within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
