Prayer in the present petition is for directing the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, SAS Nagar Mohali to decide the Execution Application No. 156/2022 in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly submits that the above said Execution Application was disposed of by the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, SAS Nagar Mohali in the month of May, 2024 and that despite the same, the compensation has not been disbursed in favour of the petitioner. He submits that he has moved an application in the month of July-2024 for seeking revival of the said execution petition.

On hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and after taking into consideration that the primary prayer made before this Court was



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to decide the execution petition which has already been disposed of by the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, SAS Nagar in the month of May-2024, I am of the opinion that no further grievance survives in the present petition. The subsequent application espousing the additional grievances has been moved only in the month of July-2024 and would be still at its initial stage.

In any case, the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission is directed to examine the grievance raised in the said application and decide the same expeditiously.
